

Doug Walker – 150 Word Biography

Originally from the Sacramento area, versatile left-handed bassist and jazz composer Doug Walker has been working the San Diego music scene for over two decades. In that time, he earned Master of Music degree from San Diego State University, became a mainstay with many of the city's celebrated artists from a wide range of genres, and developed an engagingly idiosyncratic compositional voice. Walker strives to play an integral role in every project that comes his way. On stage, he plays in the moment, ready for any spontaneous change of direction. In the studio, he delivers thoughtfully supportive bass lines worthy of their permanence. Recent recordings include Tim Flannery *The Restless Kind*, Gregory Page *One Hell of a Memory*, David Borgo *Uplift* and *Relational*, Victor Baker *As The Crow Flies*, and his debut as a leader *Concurrent Lines*; a nominee for Best Jazz Album in the 2025 San Diego Music Awards.
